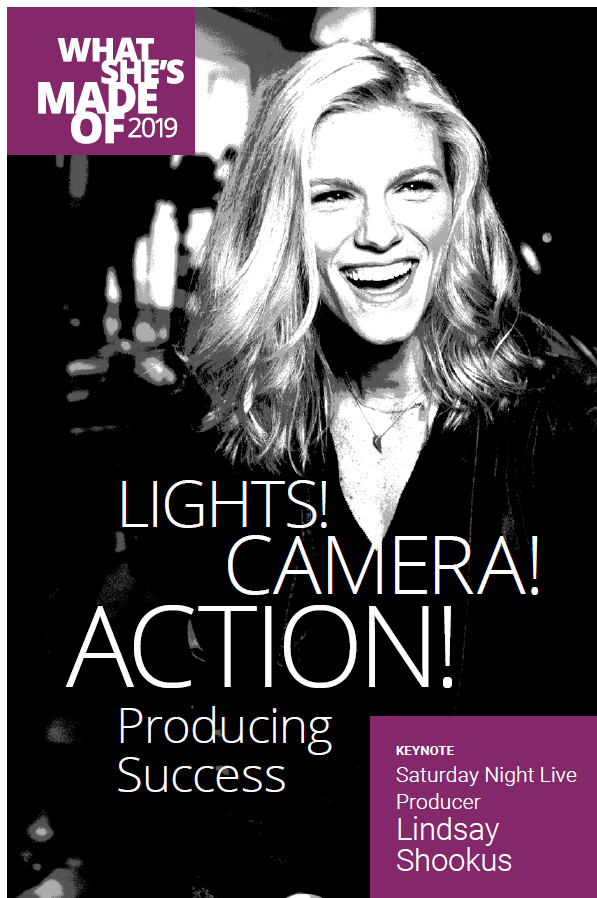

City of Buffalo Signs ALL IN Pledge



On March 29th, Mayor Byron Brown celebrated Women's History Month with a press conference where he signed the ALL IN Pledge. By signing this pledge, he has made a commitment to creating an environment of equity within the City of Buffalo to advance women as leaders in our community.

He was joined by representatives from some of the 13 WNY organizations that have already taken the ALL IN Pledge and are currently participating in the Employer Pathway of our initiative, which meets quarterly to share best practices, discuss women in the workplace and learn from one another. The organizations present at the press conference included M&T Bank, Delaware North, Harter Secrest & Emery LLP, Girl Scouts of Western New York, Lippes Mathias Wexler Friedman LLP and Linde.
