WHY VOTE?

In the 2016 primary, New York had the second lowest voter turnout in the country—**only 19.7%**

Voting ensures your voice is heard on issues that affect YOU and YOUR community.

CAN I VOTE?

You are eligible to vote if you are:

- ✓ A US Citizen
- ✓ 18 years old by the date of the election
- ✓ A resident of the state, country, city or village for at least 30 days before the election
- ✓ Not claim the right to vote elsewhere

REGISTER TO VOTE

You **MUST** register to vote at your **current** address by October 12th to be eligible.

You can register:

- ✓ Online at www.iwillvote.com
- ✓ By Mail (form at www.elections.ny.gov)
- ✓ In person at your local DMV or Board of Elections
- ✓ Call 1-800-FOR-VOTE to request an application.
