What is a Ballot Proposition?

A ballot proposition is a proposed law or amendment that is put directly to the voters for approval or rejection. It's typically used in direct democracy systems where citizens can participate directly in making laws.

Ballot propositions are usually found on your official election ballot but usually found on the other side of the sheet, which requires you to have to flip the page. They're numbered and explained clearly so voters understand them. Before voting day, check government websites or voter guides for details like the text of the propositions, arguments for and against, and who backs them.

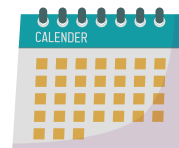
Know what is CRUCIAL information for the 2024 Election.

Currently, the State Constitution of New York does not provide protections for all its residents. For instance, individuals such as pregnant individuals, women, LGBTQIA+ individuals, those with disabilities, older adults, and people from diverse.

This Amendment guarantees protection for ALL New Yorkers.

In November 2024, New Yorkers will vote on this Amendment. Approval will integrate the ERA into New York's State Constitution, ensuring full protection of our rights.

The New York Proposition 1 aims to:

- Completely prohibit government discrimination based on ethnicity, national origin, age, disability, sex (including sexual orientation, gender identity, and gender expression), pregnancy, and pregnancy outcomes
- Expand existing protections against discrimination based on race and religion.
- Guarantee the strongest legal safeguards in New York's Constitution for all residents.
